## Criteria for Eligible Students

**Eligible students include those who are currently enrolled in a certificate or degree program at an accredited school and majoring in painting or drawing in a two dimensional format, with at least one academic year remaining.** Media may include oil, acrylics, watercolor, pastels, charcoal, color pencil, or other similar media. This **does not** include photography, computer generated art, sculpture, or textile art. ***Past \$1000 scholarship winners are not eligible.***

## Applicants must supply the following to be considered:

- I. **Completed Seattle Co-Arts 2012 Scholarship Application**
- II. **All Required Attachments** (available online at [www.seattlecoarts.com](http://www.seattlecoarts.com)).
  - A. **Student Résumé**
  - B. **Essay on Career Goals** (1-2 pages)
  - C. **Two Letters of Recommendation** One letter should be from an art instructor or advisor and relate to art ability, scholarship, and promise; the other letter should be a character reference. Both letters must include contact information for the writer so that they may be contacted if the applicant becomes a finalist.
  - D. **Two Examples of Art Work to be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee** Finalists will be required to submit additional examples of their work. All examples will be submitted electronically by email to seattlecoarts@yahoo.com, should be in JPG format, no smaller than 800 pixels in width, no larger than 1200 pixels in width or height, and should be properly labeled. All work submitted must be solely that of the applicant.
- III. **Submission Instructions are included on the application form. Finalists Will Be Interviewed In Person** and will receive the specific information of time and place at least seven days in advance.
